Dear Students, Faculty, and Staff,

Last Friday you received communication from Dean Wilson and myself informing you the College of Pharmacy will be transitioning all in-person didactic classes to an online learning environment for the two-week period following Spring Break in response to mitigating the spread of COVID-19. In alignment with the update announced by the main campus, **the College of Pharmacy will deliver all Doctor of Pharmacy didactic required and elective courses online for the remainder of the Spring 2020 semester.** The College is actively preparing for online delivery of courses to begin on Monday, March 23, 2020. Online delivery of the didactic curriculum will occur through D2L, recorded lectures, and Power Point voice-overs. Faculty course coordinators will be communicating course details directly with students.

Our primary concern is to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the College and HSC community. The College has developed an online transition process that allows us to sustain continuation of our Doctor of Pharmacy courses in the easiest, most efficient, and least disruptive process for the students, staff, and faculty. As a reminder, questions regarding didactic delivery of the program should be directed to Dean Smith and Dean Wilson. Questions regarding experiential matters of the program should be directed to Dean Dennis.

We thank all students, faculty, and staff for their patience as we move to continue delivery of our academic program. We recognize that this is a significant adjustment for all of us, and we are committed to providing the necessary support to help facilitate this effort. We appreciate your willingness, cooperation, and flexibility in working together to ensure we offer the best educational experience during this unique time.
