The Student Health Clinic provides convenient, high-quality healthcare designed specifically for students. Located within the Family Medicine Center – Green Clinic, we offer a wide range of services to help you stay healthy, focused, and supported throughout your time on campus.

STUDENT HEALTH FEE COVERAGE

Students are able to be seen at the Student Health Clinic free of charge for the following issues:

- Acute Care Visits are office visits for one minor illness
- Injury that is less than 2 weeks in duration
- Acute respiratory infections (colds, flu, bronchitis, sinus infections)
- Acute skin infections and rashes
- Acute allergy or asthma exacerbations
- Ear infections
- Sore throat
- Cough
- Conjunctivitis (i.e., pink eye, allergies)
- Bladder infection symptoms
- Nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Recent musculoskeletal injuries – sprains, strains, acute back pain or acute joint pain
- Acute injuries requiring wound evaluation and/or wound closure
- Travel medicine consultation appointments with a medical provider

ACCESS TO CARE

Student Health is open Monday – Friday from 7:30AM – 4:30PM.

Students are welcome to call the clinic to schedule or walk in.

INSURANCE COVERAGE

Students may present to clinic with a need that is not covered by the Student Health Fee. In that case, the Student's Insurance is billed. Deductible and/or co-insurance expenses may apply. Examples include:

- Office visits for multiple issues
- Office visits for chronic problems (defined as having symptoms greater than 2 weeks)
- Office visits requiring medication refills and/or medication monitoring
- Office visits to discuss referrals to a specialist if indicated
- Annual physical exams
- Board licensure, pre-rotation, and pre-employment physicals
- Well Woman Exams including pap smears
- All imaging studies (x-rays, ultrasounds, CTs, MRIs)
- All bloodwork processed outside of clinic
- STD evaluation and testing
- Female and reproductive related issues
- Vaccinations
- TB screening (TB skin test)
- Blood titers to check for immunity against infectious diseases
- All acute, chronic, and preventative healthcare services provided for insured spouses and dependents of students
- Blood borne pathogen exposure bloodwork – Billed to the needle stick coverage component of health insurance
